Where?

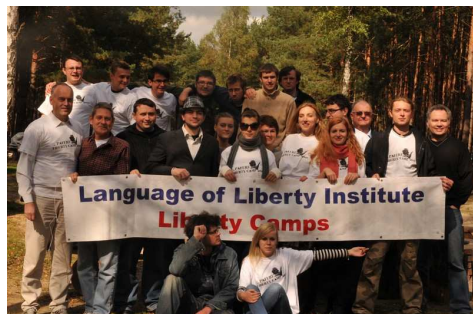
